



Stroke Format

- In MiScore, select 'Putts Enabled' via Menu/Settings/Putts Enabled. Putts are counted on all stroke days to determine EOY Putting Awards.
- Stroke play is an individual pursuit against the entire field.
- The player counts the number of strokes they have until the hole is completed.
- Players add up their scores for each hole to arrive at their gross score.
- Players subtract their handicap from their gross score to get their net score.
- The player with the lowest net score wins.
- For a player to play to their handicap in stroke, they need to finish with a net score of even par. Par at YB is 70.
If a player with a handicap of 18, shoots a gross score of 88, their net score is 88 less 18 handicap, equalling 70. They have played to par.

RULES of STROKE:

- Scoring: Every player will exchange scorecards or be scored by someone else on MiScore.
- Record Strokes: Players must record the number of strokes taken on each hole, no gimmies!! However.....
- Pace of play: YBLGC has introduced MAXIMUM SCORE RULE. This allows players to pick up after 3 strokes over net Par without being disqualified, although it does exclude the player from winning the day's event or the Monthly Medal.
- Compare score: Players compare their scores and putts to determine that they have the same result. Once agreed and signed, submit scores, either on card or on MiScore.
- Clubs: A player is allowed to carry a maximum of 14 clubs.
